2020 Annual subscription renewal due from January

If you set up your payment for 2019 by standing order or joined through the IA website, you do not need to do anything as your renewal will have been paid automatically on 1st January 2020, or 12 months after you joined. If you don't currently pay by standing order, a data collection exercise is being organised by our national office and as part of this they will issue you a standing order form which you can complete and pass to your bank to action. If you want to pay by cheque or bank transfer the details you need are below. Please ensure that on whatever payment method you choose that you state your Surname-Postcode, e,g, Minto-LS2 7UA otherwise we will not know you have paid. Research - How has the group been involved, by Maureen Naylor

For the last 5 years I've been a Patient and Public Involvement (PPI) Representative for the Colorectal Therapies Initiative, funded by the National Institute for Health Research (NIHR). This has now expanded to include heart, liver and pancreatic disease and is called the Surgical MedTech Cooperative, which is again funded by the NIHR, and will also run for another 5 years. The research group consists of clinicians, scientists, engineers, industry and patients. I'm now a member of the newly formed PPI committee for the MedTech Initiative and again represent the IA.

I attended a 2-day training course on Public Involvement in Health Research at Barnsley College, but run by York University. This was a very interesting and informative day. Over the past 5 years I've been lucky enough to be a PPI representative on several research projects including: -

The development of a surgical platform; The patient representative looking at the research done by Coloplast into stoma care follow up after surgery; The initial PPI representative for the Ileus research done at Leeds hospital, and now part of the PPI group. It is hoped that the research will expand to Bradford. I've also been involved in the development of a new booklet for the "recovery after surgery project", for Leeds hospitals. I have really enjoyed and been fascinated by my involvement in the research process and seeing how new areas of innovation are identified and research is supported and helped to move into clinical practice.
